\$500 Award

To recognize achievement and the impact that Mock Trial has on the lives of the students who participate, the South Carolina Bar Law Related Education (LRE) Division has created a scholarship program for SC Mock Trial participants to apply for in their senior year. The selected recipients of the \$500 Mock Trial scholarships must have participated in Mock Trial at either the district or the state level of competition during their Mock Trial experience to qualify for the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements for Applicants:

1. Must currently be a high school senior (but not required to have participated this year);
2. Must have participated in a Mock Trial program in South Carolina;
3. Must be or have been a member of a High School Mock Trial team that participated in a competition sponsored by the SC Bar LRE Division;
4. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5; and
5. Must plan to attend a post-secondary institution such as a technical, 2-year or 4-year college/university.

Evaluation/Award Process:

1. Members of the LRE Awards Committee will evaluate the applications.
2. The LRE Division will notify recipients by May 5, 2015.

Application Procedure:

1. Complete the application cover sheet.
2. Explain what Mock Trial has meant to you in no more than three (3) pages, typed, 12 point font, one inch margins, and double spaced. Consider discussion of the following:
 - a. Why did you participate in Mock Trial?
 - b. What specific achievements did you learn?
 - c. What contributions did you give the team?
 - d. What roles did you play throughout your experience?
3. Attach two (2) Recommendation Forms, at least one of which must come from your Mock Trial teacher or attorney coach.
4. Include a sealed copy of your high school transcript through fall of your senior year.
**** Please note that your social security number should not appear on any records submitted to the SC Bar.**
5. Return one (1) original, hole punched nomination packet. **Packets must be postmarked to the SC Bar LRE Division no later than March 20, 2015.**
6. Please do not put any pages in plastic protector sheets.
