

TWELFTH STUDY RETREAT FOR LAWYERS IN RECOVERY

The Lawyer Assistance Programs of Virginia, North Carolina and South Carolina are pleased to sponsor another step study retreat for lawyers and law students in recovery. Please copy and distribute this information to lawyers or law students in recovery that you know who might be interested.

WHEN:

The Retreat will be held Friday evening, April 4 through Sunday lunch, April 6, 2008. Check in time for sleeping rooms is 3 p.m. The program will start with dinner at 6:00 p.m. Participants may arrive earlier and enjoy the grounds and facilities.

WHERE:

Kanuga, an Episcopal Conference Center in Hendersonville, NC, is situated on 1,400 acres in the mountains at 2,300 feet above sea level.

WHO:

This retreat is ideal for lawyers and law students who are in any stage of recovery. If you are new in recovery and want to gain more knowledge of how to work the 12-steps or if you are already in recovery and desire a deeper understanding of the 12-steps, your time in attending this workshop shall be well spent. In the past, we have received questions regarding attendance by spouses, significant others, other volunteers or staff. If these other persons are working a 12-step program themselves, they are welcome. If they are not working a 12-step program, but have a sincere interest in learning, an understanding of what they will be participating in, and a commitment to confidentiality and anonymity, they are welcome.

RETREAT LEADER:

Don H. Major, graduated from the University of Louisville School of Law and began his law practice in Louisville in 1968. Concentrating in the areas of criminal defense and plaintiffs' personal injury he is, today, a sole practitioner in Louisville. Due to alcoholism and drug addiction, Don's life and law

practice fell apart in the late 1970's. He was blessed with reaching recovery and has been in recovery continuously since 1981. Don is nationally known as a speaker and trainer on various topics at AA Conference and Conventions. He is extremely active in recovery and spends about half of his weekends traveling to carry that message. Today he is a volunteer for K.L.A.P. (Kentucky Lawyer's Assistance Program), a member of the Kentucky Bar Ethics Committee and the Ethics Hotline. He is a Master at the Brandeis Inn of Court and was chosen as the Louisville Bar Association's *pro bono* lawyer of the year in 2003.

COST:

Your registration fee and charges for lodging and meals must be paid directly to the South Carolina State Bar, attention Robert Turnbull. **Payment must be made in full by March 18, 2008 and refunds will not be possible after that date, unless someone else is able to take your space.**

A registration fee of \$65 per person (\$30 for law students) is charged to cover retreat expenses. **It is very important to us that retreat expenses do not deter someone who would like to attend.** If you or someone you know wants to attend and has financial barriers, please let the Lawyer Assistance Program in your state know so that we can seek financial assistance.

Cost of lodging/meals is \$258 per person (single) for the weekend and \$196 per person (double) for the weekend. The charge per person per night covers lodging, three meals, two snacks, use of the meeting room and audiovisual equipment. If you want to attend the meetings and have meals, but not stay in the rooms, there is a daily fee for the cost of meals and use of the facility.

We will allow people to register for single occupancy of motel-type rooms only as long as it does not prohibit registration for all persons desiring to attend.

In other words, we will work to accommodate single occupancy but cannot guarantee it.

After you register a letter of confirmation will be mailed to you. Please keep the flyer with the directions for travel to the conference.

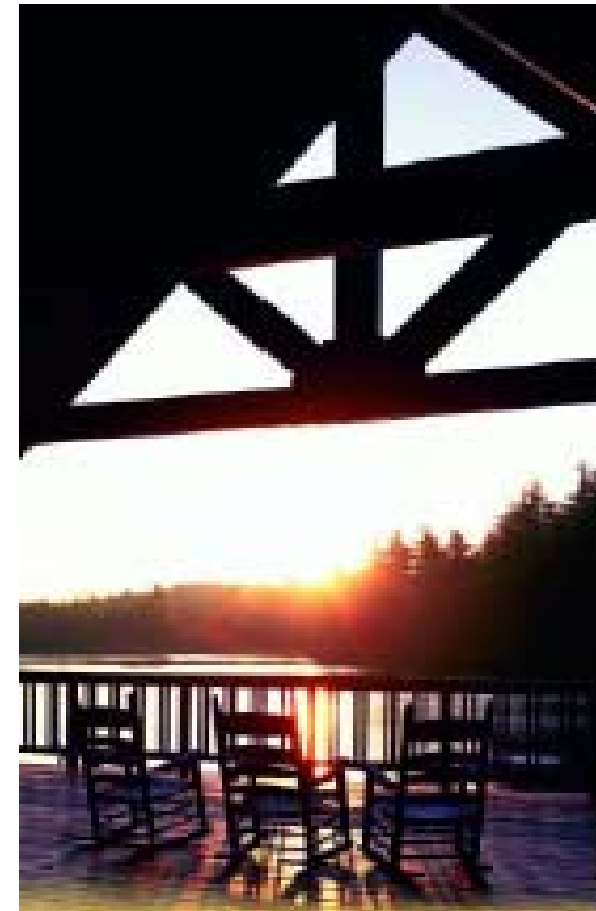
