



Elementary Mock Trial is an excellent way to introduce the concepts of justice and the judiciary system through the use of fairy tale mock trials. We all know the stories of Goldilocks, Paul Bunyan, The Three Little Pigs, and many others. The SC Bar supplies elementary teachers case materials created by the American Bar Association and the Maine State Bar Association. Through these fairy tale cases, students can learn about the courts in an interactive fashion.

The fairy tale cases are typically played out by upper elementary student to an audience of primary grade students. There are several roles in each case to include a presiding judge, a bailiff, and attorneys and witnesses for both sides. The SC Bar LRE Division provides puppets for all the roles including jurors. The case materials and the use of the puppets are available on a “loan basis” for FREE.

Once the students are comfortable with their roles, a presentation date can be arranged with the SC Bar LRE Division. A member of the LRE Division will come and film the presentation for the school to keep. A presentation date can be scheduled with Cynthia H. Cothran at ccothran@scbar.org.

While everything is free, there is a \$50 deposit to use the puppets that will be returned upon receipt of the puppets to the SC Bar. There is also a non-refundable \$1 per puppet shipping fee.

The case is mailed immediately upon receipt of this application. Once you have had a chance to work on the case with your students and have assigned roles, you can order the puppets that will correspond to the students playing each role. You may also want to order additional puppets for jurors in an effort to include as many students as possible in the presentation of the case.

Puppets are shipped two weeks prior to the presentation date. Please complete the Puppet Order Form at least three weeks before your presentation date so that the puppets can be shipped to you.

On the presentation date, a SC Bar staff member will arrive to film the Elementary Mock Trial. All students and teachers will be required to submit signed Talent Release forms before they are allowed to be a part of the filming. The SC Bar will collect all of the puppets at the completion of the mock trial presentation.

By signing this registration form, I understand that I am responsible for the care and return of the puppets that are mailed to me for use in our Elementary Mock Trial presentation. A \$50 refundable deposit is required before the puppets are shipped and a shipping fee of \$1 per puppet is required. (The deposit check and the shipping check are two separate checks. Checks should be made payable to the SC Bar-LRE Division.) Should the puppets be returned in any less condition than received, the \$50 deposit will not be refunded. While the puppets are in my care, I promise to maintain their cleanliness and upkeep. Students will be asked to wash their hands before using the puppets to help ensure their cleanliness.
