INTERPRETING YOUR RESULTS

This report summarizes the overall results of the South Carolina Bar Member Survey.

There are five sections to this report:

- **1) Demographics.** This section summarizes the number of respondents in each demographic category including workplace, gender, age, ethnicity, sexual orientation and disability status.
- 2) Index Scores: This section displays index scores. This chart illustrates the average percent favorable across all items in each category.
- **3) SC Bar Survey Results.** This section displays the results for each item on the survey. Each item was rated on a 7 point scale. Results are displayed as percent favorable (6,7s), percent neutral (3,4,5s) and percent unfavorable (1,2s). The top three scoring items are highlighted in green and the three lowest scoring items are highlighted in red in the overall % favorable column.
- **4) Membership Experience.** This section displays the results for each item related to member experience familiary with programs and leadership, participation in sections and committees.
- **5) Demographic Analysis:** This section displays index scores by each of the key demographics workplace, gender, age, ethnicity, sexual orientation and disability status. Where found, statistical differences are indicated by column letter (eg. A,B = a significant difference was found at the p=0.05 level between data in column A and B)
